



# **LEGISLATIVE GOALS 2022**

#### **Active Libraries with Current Books, Programs and Services**

- Increase Grants in Aid funding to public libraries.
- Support the unique focus of the West Virginia Library Commission to ensure the continuing development of library services across the state that serve the learning needs of all West Virginians.
  - 1. Increase the Services to Libraries line item by \$200,000
  - 2. Approve one time \$200,000 appropriation to help libraries that have lost 10% or more of their service population.

#### **Safe and Modern Buildings**

• Fund the Library Facilities Improvement Fund with a non-recurring appropriation of \$10,000,000

## **Adequate & Affordable Broadband**

- Empower public libraries and other community anchor institutions to promote digital equity to all West Virginians with programs, education, and connections.
- Support legislation resulting in robust, high-speed, affordable broadband internet connections to all areas, individuals, private and public sectors in the state.
